
The following Board Topics (Item 6) were discussed:


The next Regular Board meeting will be September 11, 2018 at 11:00 am. by motion made (Hoffman moved, Williams seconded) and carried.

Emeritus Members may attend meetings or serve the National Council of Examiners for Engineering and Surveying (NCEES) in the capacity of a NCEES Emeritus Member of the Board as defined in the NCEES bylaws.

Emeritus Member status is an honorary title that serves at the pleasure of the Board; therefore, if an Emeritus Member does not act in accordance with Board policy, rules and/or statutes, this status may be terminated by a majority vote of the full Board.
