

**BEFORE THE ARKANSAS BOARD OF REGISTRATION FOR  
PROFESSIONAL ENGINEERS AND LAND SURVEYORS**

**Case #2008-21, in the matter of Achala Services:**

**COMPLAINT**

The Arkansas Board of Registration for Professional Engineers and Land Surveyors (hereinafter "the Board") received a complaint on June 18, 2008, charging Achala Services (non-registrant, hereinafter "Achala") with offering to provide engineering services in Arkansas without a valid Certificate of Authorization, in violation of Arkansas Code Annotated §17-30-303(a)(1)(C).

**FINDINGS OF FACT**

1. On May 8, 2008, Tommy Bond (AR-PE #2219) received an e-mail message from Umesh, on behalf of Achala Services. In part, that message stated: "We are Civil Engineers team in India. We hold an Estimation Consultancy firm in India. We offers Quantity take off service for Contractors, Architect and Engineering firms . . ."
2. Estimation and quantity take-off are not strictly regarded as engineering services.


**CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**

Upon review of the evidence in its possession, the Board finds Achala's actions as described in the Findings of Fact do not constitute a violation of the statutes or rules governing the Arkansas Board of Registration for Professional Engineers and Land Surveyors.

**ORDER**

Based on these findings, the complaint against Achala is dismissed without further action by the Board.


