

BEFORE THE ARKANSAS BOARD OF LICENSURE FOR
PROFESSIONAL ENGINEERS AND PROFESSIONAL SURVEYORS

Case #2007-09¹⁸, in the matter of James Collins:

COMPLAINT

The Arkansas Board of Licensure for Professional Engineers and Professional Surveyors (hereinafter "the Board") registered a complaint on August 20, 2007, charging James E. Collins (AR-PS #1337, hereinafter "Collins") with failure to file a survey plat with the circuit court clerk, in violation of Arkansas Code Annotated §17-48-106(a).

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. At the time of the complaint, the Complainant was a member of the Marion County Planning Board.
2. In consideration of a matter involving a local property owner, the survey plat needed for resolution was found not to have been filed by Collins with the circuit clerk.
3. In filing his Answer to the complaint, Collins admitted that he had not filed the survey with the circuit clerk.


CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

Upon review of the evidence in its possession, the Board finds Collins' actions as described in the Findings of Fact do not warrant further action by the Arkansas Board of Licensure for Professional Engineers and Professional Surveyors.

ORDER

Based on these findings, the complaint against Collins is dismissed without further action by the Board.
