
**IN THE MATTER OF MICHAEL JAMES, PS:**

**DISMISSAL ORDER**

The Arkansas Board of Registration for Professional Engineers and Land Surveyors (hereinafter "the Board") received a complaint on February 28, 2007, charging Michael E. James (PS #985, hereinafter referred to as "the Respondent"), with a violation of Arkansas Code Annotated §17-48-102(b) (incompetence and/or negligence).

The Respondent filed his answer to the charge with the Board on April 23, 2007, and provided additional information on July 20, 2007. On September 13, 2007, the Complaint Committee of the Board voted to recommend dismissal of the charge against the Respondent based on the answers provided. On November 13, 2007, the Board voted to dismiss the charge.


