

**BEFORE THE ARKANSAS BOARD OF REGISTRATION FOR  
PROFESSIONAL ENGINEERS AND LAND SURVEYORS**

**Case #2008-26, in the matter of Kevin Kirchmer:**

**COMPLAINT**

The Arkansas Board of Registration for Professional Engineers and Land Surveyors (hereinafter "the Board") received a complaint on August 20, 2008, charging Kevin Louis Kirchmer (non-registrant, hereinafter "Kirchmer"), representing Engineering Design & Testing Corporation (non-registrant, hereinafter "EDTC"), with practicing and/or offering to practice engineering in Arkansas, in violation of Arkansas Code Annotated §17-30-102(b), and EDTC with offering to provide engineering services in Arkansas as an incorporated entity without a Certificate of Authorization from the Board, in violation of §17-30-303(a)(1)(C).

**FINDINGS OF FACT**

1. On June 20, 2008, the Board received an application from Kirchmer for Professional Engineering registration by reciprocity.
2. When the application was reviewed by the Board on August 8/5/08, Kirchmer's statements in the "NOTICE" indicated he had possibly offered to practice and/or practiced engineering in Arkansas. The staff of the Board was ordered to initiate an investigation into possible violations, and the application was tabled pending the outcome of the investigation.
3. The staff investigation found no evidence of violation.

**CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**

Upon review of the evidence in its possession, the Board finds Kirchmer's and EDTC's actions as described in the Findings of Fact do not constitute a violation of the statutes or rules governing the Arkansas Board of Registration for Professional Engineers and Land Surveyors.

**ORDER**

Based on these findings, the complaint against Kirchmer is dismissed without further action by the Board.


