

**BEFORE THE ARKANSAS BOARD OF REGISTRATION FOR

IN THE MATTER OF STEWART NOLAND, PE #4787.

DISMISSAL ORDER

The Arkansas Board of Registration for Professional Engineers and Land Surveyors (hereinafter "the Board") received a complaint charging Stewart Noland, PE #4787 (hereinafter referred to as "Respondent"), with violations of the following laws, rules, and regulations governing the practice of professional engineering in the state of Arkansas: Arkansas Code Annotated § 17-30-305(a)(4), and Article 12, Section B, Paragraph 4(c) of the Rules of the Board.

Respondent appeared before the Board for a hearing on May 8, 2007, where he made a satisfactory response to the charges against him, and after deliberation, the Board voted to dismiss the charges without prejudice.


