# BEFORE THE ARKANSAS BOARD OF REGISTRATION FOR PROFESSIONAL ENGINEERS AND LAND SURVEYORS

Case #2008-33, in the matter of Dean Lewis Purdy:

### **COMPLAINT**

The Arkansas Board of Registration for Professional Engineers and Land Surveyors (hereinafter "the Board") brought a complaint on September 24, 2008, charging Dean Lewis Purdy (non-registrant, hereinafter "Purdy") with the practice of, or offer to practice, engineering in Arkansas without registration.

## **FINDINGS OF FACT**

- 1. Purdy is not now, nor has he ever been, registered as a Professional Engineer in Arkansas.
- 2. On 7/21/08, the Board received an application from Purdy for Professional Engineering registration by reciprocity.
- 3. When the application was reviewed by the Board on 9/9/08, Purdy's statements in the "NOTICE" indicated he had certainly offered to practice engineering, and probably practiced engineering, in Arkansas.
- 4. Purdy's firm, TLCP, Inc, held/holds Certificate of Authorization #1801 in Arkansas. The engineer of record for the firm was/is James Tribolet (AR-PE #9568).

#### **CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**

Upon review of the evidence in its possession, the Board finds the allegation of unregistered practice and/or offer to practice engineering to be unsupported by the Findings of Fact outlined above.

#### <u>ORDER</u>

Based on these findings, the complaint against Purdy is dismissed without further action by the Board.
