DISMISSAL ORDER

The Arkansas Board of Licensure for Professional Engineers and Professional Surveyors (hereinafter "the Board") registered a complaint on November 13, 2009, charging Jason McConnell Willett (PE #13932, hereinafter "Willett") with violation of Arkansas Code Annotated §17-30-305(a)(5) (discipline by another jurisdiction where the grounds for discipline were the same or substantially equivalent to those in Arkansas).

FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. Willett notified the Board on November 13, 2009, that he had been disciplined by the Oklahoma Board.
- 2. Willett, through his firm Willett Engineering Company, did structural engineering work for a national account client (Chick-fil-A) for projects in Oklahoma.
- 3. Although Willett held Professional Engineer registration in Oklahoma at the time, his firm had allowed its Certificate of Authorization to practice in Oklahoma to lapse.
- 4. Willett was charged with aiding his firm to violate the rules of the Oklahoma Board.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

Arkansas Code Annotated §17-30-305(a)(5) provides that the Board may discipline licensees for conduct in another jurisdiction which would also be a violation in Arkansas, but does not require it to do so.

Upon review of the evidence in its possession, the Board finds the conduct by Willett described in the Findings of Fact does not warrant further investigation or other action.

<u>ORDER</u>

Based on these findings, the complaint against Willett is dismissed.
